**Information Sheet 2024 **

Dear Parent:

We are quickly approaching our summer season. This General Information sheet will answer most of your questions:

DATES OF CAMP: June 27, 2024 to August 22, 2024. Camp is Closed Thursday & Friday July 4th, & 5th.

<u>MEDICAL FORMS:</u> Medical forms can be downloaded <u>here</u>. They must be completed and returned before June 10th. Only medical forms dated 8/20/23 or later are acceptable. <u>Please be sure to read and sign the Authorization for Treatment at the bottom of the medical form.</u>

<u>CAMP NURSES</u> will be available on 6/18/24 from 10am-12pm AND 6/24/22 from 5PM-7PM to accept medications and/or to discuss any medical issues.

TRANSPORTATION: If taking the bus, your child's bus driver will visit your home one to three days before the start of camp.

If you are unavailable, the driver will leave the following information in your mailbox: Campers' group name, route number, approximate time of pick up, driver & bus counselor's name and phone number. *PLEASE DO NOT CALL US UNLESS YOU HAVE NOT BEEN CONTACTED BY 3:00 PM SUNDAY JUNE 26*th.

IF PROVIDING YOUR OWN TRANSPORTATION: We will notify you of your campers drop off and pick up times approximately 10 days prior to the start of camp.

ORIENTATIONS:

All campers will have the opportunity to meet with their Group leaders and fellow campers prior to the start of camp during an informal MEET N GREET when you pick up your child's T-Shirt and camp bags. (dates to be announced)

*NURSERY & KINDERGARTEN PARENT ORIENTATION: There will be an in-person Orientation for Parents-Only, dates to be announced. If you cannot attend, not to worry, we will email you a copy of everything we cover that evening.

*EXTREME TEEN ORIENTATION: There will be a mandatory parent/camper orientation for our Extreme Teens, Dates to be announced, for first time campers in that program. Returning EXTREME TEEN campers should arrive by 7pm.

<u>CLOTHING:</u> Campers should bring the following items to camp: Three or four bathing suits, a pair of sandals, water shoes, flip flops or Crocs and a sweatshirt, sweater or light jacket. Bathing suits will be sent home each Friday for laundering. Please be sure to label *all* of your child's belongings.

Kenwal Day Camp will provide all necessary equipment to be used for ALL activities in camp including Sunscreen and Towels. We will be handing out camper t-shirts and bags for all campers at the informal "Meet N Greets".

Please do not send your child to camp with handheld electronic games or cell phones.

<u>LUNCHES</u>: Hot/cold lunch will be provided for all campers. **Our lunch menu can be found <u>here</u>**. Camp Kenwal provides drinks (fruit punch or water) for all campers.
